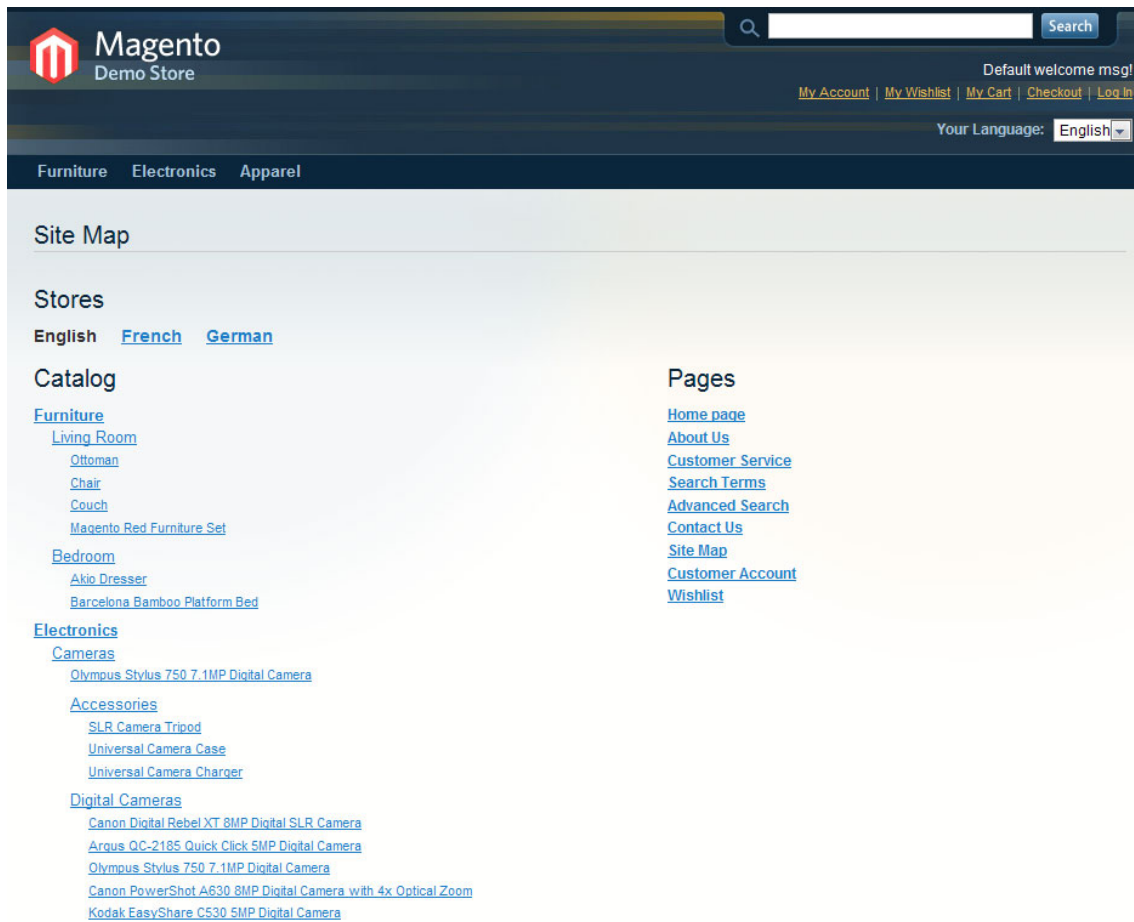

Extension Description

Extended Sitemap allows you to display all of your existing Catalog Categories, Products, CMS Pages and additional configurable links on a single Site Map page accessible at your store footer link, e.g. <http://www.example.com/sitemap/>

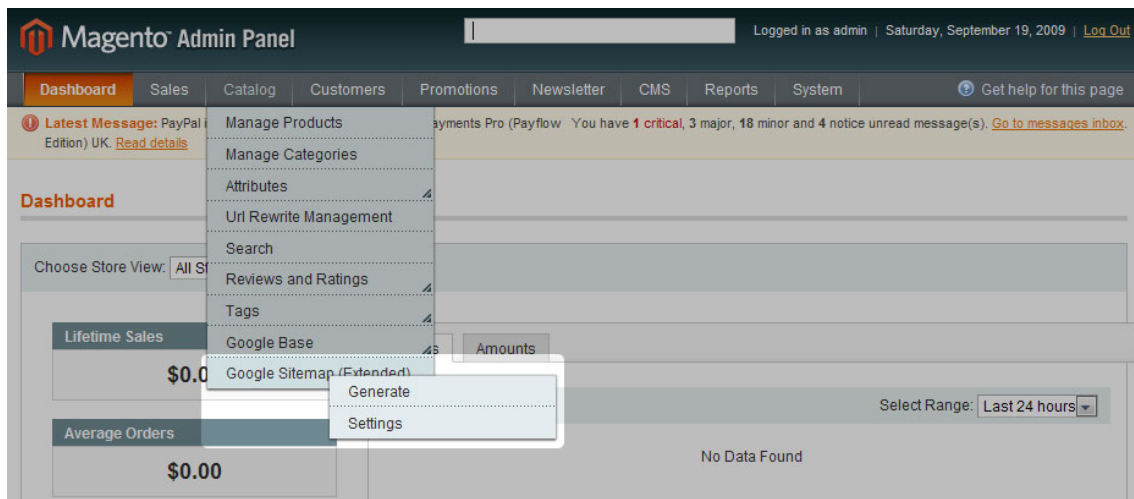
Moreover hierarchical structure of all the elements is SEO optimized for web spiders.



In addition Magento Google Sitemap feature for auto generation of XML Site Map files is replaced by optimized and advanced functionality to simplify user experience.

Extension Installation

- 1 Log out from Magento Admin panel if you are logged in
- 2 Unpack the contents of the 'extension' folder from the package file purchased from MageWorx to your Magento root folder
- 3 Log into Magento Admin Panel
- 4 If Cache Control is enabled in Magento go to 'System > Cache Management' section, select 'Refresh' under 'All Cache' drop-down menu and press 'Save Cache Settings'
- 5 Now check the top menu, 'Catalog' section. If A new sub category 'Google Sitemap (Extended)' exists you are done with installation



Extension Usage

- 1 First, log into Magento Admin panel and go to 'Catalog > Google Sitemap (Extended) > Settings' to configure Site Map Settings for your front-end Site Map page

In order to make your site more SEO optimized and user friendly configure the following:

- **Show Stores** option switches on/off links display of your Store Views if you have a multi store view website
 - **Show Categories** option switches on/off links display of your Catalog Categories
 - **Show Products** option switches on/off links display of your Catalog Products in a hierarchical structure when every Product is being displayed under his parent Category
 - **Show CMS Pages** option switches on/off links display of your CMS Pages
 - **Filter CMS Pages** option allows you to select CMS pages you do not want to be included in your Site Map
 - **Show Footer Links** option switches on/off links display from your store footer links
 - **Additional Links** field allows you to append your Site Map with some additional links not available in any of previous sections
- 2 Next, configure Google Sitemap (Extended) settings for auto generation of XML Site Map files


- 3 Now go to 'Catalog > Google Sitemap (Extended) > Generate' to generate your new Google Site Map files
